 to Aug. 7, 1870 2840 pp. He removed to Callahan's Ranch, Cal.
 where his sons lived soon after 1870 & died there Nov. 20, 1874.

June 13, 1829: Capt. Eliphalet Buck of Eastport died last night

June 28, 1832 Buck & Tenkham's brig launched at Mill.

Called the Lincoln built by Elisha & Warren Vase

Oct. 25, 1832 The Henry Clay launched from J. N. M. Brewer's yard

Aug 17, 1841 Brig Copenang (?) was launched. About 140 tons
